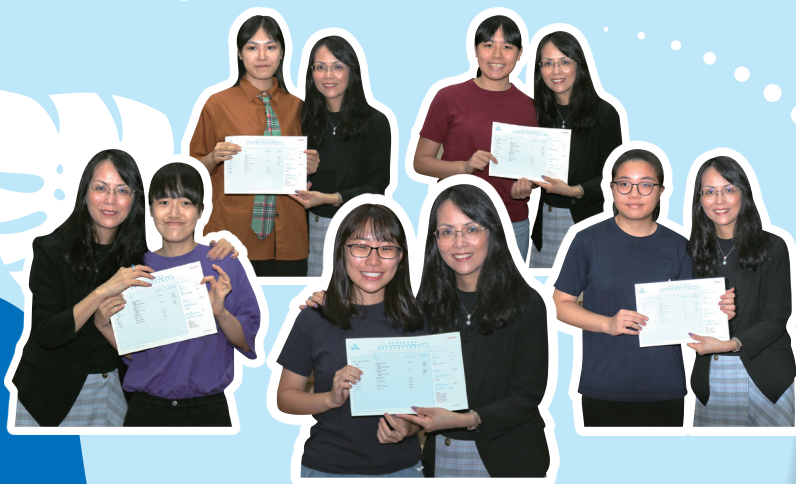

Languages, Humanities and Entrepreneurship



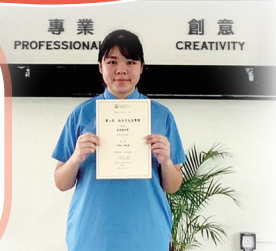
A group of S3 students won in "Teen Time: Broadcasting Workshop Series". They developed a programme called "Off The Grid", aired on RTHK3.

The school team was the Champion in Grade C and 3rd runner-up in Grade B. They were the overall 2nd Runner-up of the Inter-school Cross Country Competition.



Our swimming team was the Overall Champion in Grade A in the Inter-School Swimming Competition.



Our school basketball team came in third in Grade C, 1st runner-up in the HKCCCC's 3 on 3 Basketball Competition 2018-2019 and the championship in the 8th Borderless Sports Day Basketball Competition.

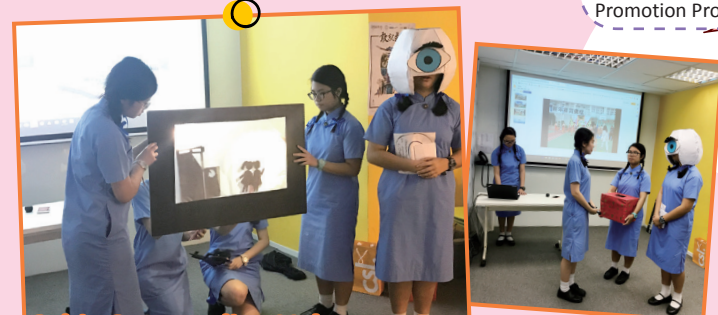


A visit to Food Angel
