Our S6 students faced unprecedented challenges this year. Yet, with the unrelenting effort of themselves and the unyielding support of teachers and parents, they achieved gratifying results in HKDSE 2020. Overall speaking, the 33222 attainment percentage is 86%. In 7 subjects, students achieved better than the Hong Kong average at level 5 or above. In 11 subjects, students achieved better than the Hong Kong average at level 4 or above.

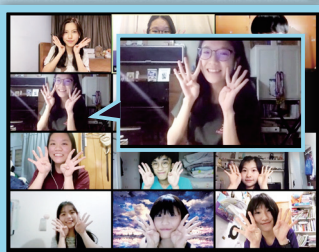

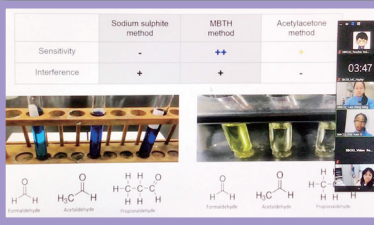


Lok Yee Ching (S5) received a merit award in the solo event of the 56th Schools Dance Festival: Chinese Dance.

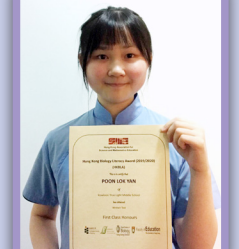
STEM

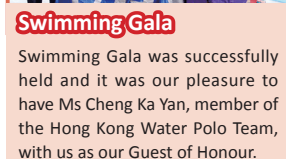


S4 Learning Camp

A tea gathering was held on Information day and it was a great opportunity for our parents to share their experience and answer inquiries from visiting parents.



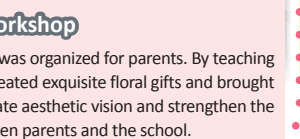
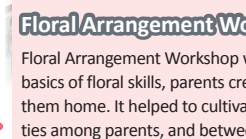
PTA Christmas Party

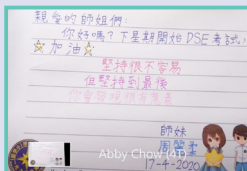

S6 students visited the ICAC Headquarter and had a thorough understanding of the mission of ICAC and they learnt how to prevent corruption from happening in their future careers.



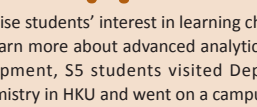
Visit to RTHK

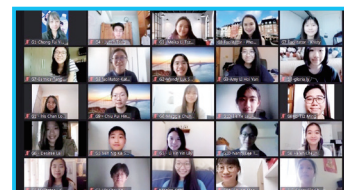
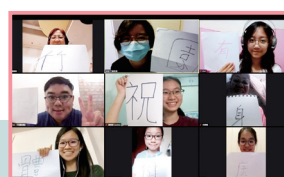
Online Conference with Kyoto Prefectural Yamashiro Senior High School

Knitting Scarves for the Elderly



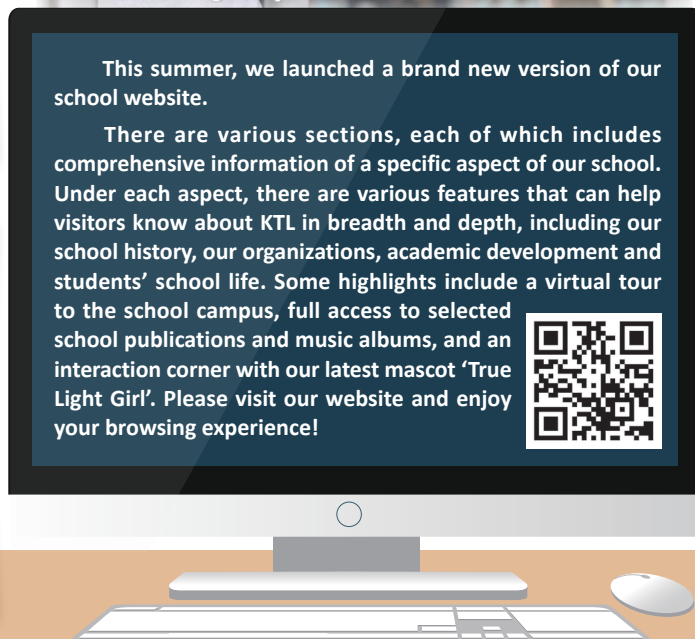
Our students volunteered to learn how to knit a scarf and sent love and care to the elderly by hand-made sewing gift packs in winter.

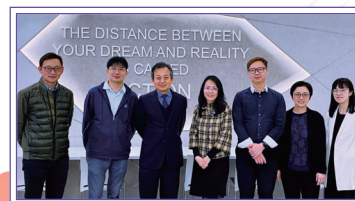
Principal Lee Appointed Member of Kowloon City District Youth Network Advisory Committee
