

Plan on the Use of the Promotion of Reading Grant

2023-2024 School Year

The major objectives of promoting reading: (e.g. creating a reading culture)

- This year, RPC has selected "The Power of Thought, the Magic of Mind" as the theme for the current academic year, aligning with the school's theme of the year and core values.
- RPC will organize a series of reading activities and procure books related to the theme to cultivate correct values, deepen students' understanding, and foster a love for reading.
- RPC is introducing a new programme - "Reading Assembly-Morning Silence Reading" with a focus on exploring the theme of "The Power of Thought, the Magic of Mind." The programme involves teachers and reading ambassadors sharing and reading activities that encourage critical thinking and reflection. The project aims to encourage students to progress from reading to writing and from writing to critical thinking, while enhancing students' moral character, values, and bilingual reading abilities.
- Book-mates Sharing Session: provides S1-2 students with the opportunity to share and discuss their reading experiences in a supportive environment.
- Pop-up Library: A temporary library is set up where students can browse and borrow books of their choice, promoting a culture of exploration and discovery.
- Cross-form Reading Sharing: Collaborative reading sessions are organized between students from different forms, such as S5 and S2, as well as S4 and S1. This encourages peer interaction and the sharing of diverse perspectives.
- Lunchtime Reading Workshops: Workshops are conducted during lunchtime to develop students' reading skills and foster a deeper understanding of various literary genres and techniques.
